As of November 19, 2001, the New Jersey DEP Pesticide Control Program instituted a new program that requires us to provide customers with information about the pesticides that we will be using as part of the pest control program for your property. If applications are made to ornamentals or turf, at least one sign will be placed on the property that says PESTICIDE TREATED AREA and contains the international signage for KEEP OFF THE GRASS. We are required to do this by regulation. The sign must remain in place for a minimum of 72 hours following the application of a pesticide. To help keep the cost of the new program at a minimum, we are requesting that our customers be responsible for removing the sign no sooner than 72 hours following each pesticide application. We would appreciate it if you would do so.
